#### GUJARAT PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL EDUCATIONAL COLLEGES OR INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION AND FIXATION OF FEES) ACT, 2007.

**No.GH/SH/05-2009/PVS/102008/1641/S.**- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 20 read with section 4 of the Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institution (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007 (Guj. 2 of 2008), the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Course (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules 2008, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Course (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 2009.
2. In the Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Course (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules; 2008 (hereinafter referred to as "the said rules") in rule 6,-
  - (1) In sub-rule (1) for clauses (ii) to (iv), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely :-
    - " (ii) The Central Board of Secondary Education Board Provided that,-
      - (a) the School in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the State of Gujarat; or
      - (b) the school in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the Union Territories of Diu, Daman and Dadra Nagar Haveli and whose parents are origin of Gujarat; or

(iii) the Council of Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi :

Provided that,-

- (a) the School in which the candidate as studied, should have been located in the State of Gujarat; or
- (b) the school in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the Union Territories of Diu Daman and Dadra Nagar Haveli and whose parents are origin of Gujarat, and

(iv) appeared in the Hotel and Tourism Management Common Entrance Test (HTMCET) conducted in the relevant academic year,".

(2) Sub-rule (6) shall be deleted.

3. In the said rules, after rule 9, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-

**"9A Reservation of seats for migrants of the State of Jammu and Kashmir .-** (1)(a) One supernumerary seat in each college of institute shall be reserved for the candidates who are migrants' of the State of Jammu and Kashmir in accordance with the directions of the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India;

(b) Such seats shall be filled by such migrants' candidates who are otherwise eligible for admission under these rules.

(2) Such migrants' candidate shall be exempted from appearing in the Gujarat Common Entrance Test. "

4. In the said rules, after rule 23, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-

**"23A Submission of report .-** The Admission Committee shall submit the detailed report of admission as may be required by the Government, to the Director of Technical Education, Gujarat State and to the State Government within two months after completion of the admission process."
