Constitution of India.

No. GH/SH/53/PRE/112013/4484/K :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Taluka Primary Education Officer, Class II, in the Gujarat Education Service, under the Directorate of Primary Education, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Taluka Primary Education Officer Class II, under the Directorate of Primary Education, Recruitment Rules, 2019.
2. Appointment to the post of Taluka Primary Education Officer Class II, in the Gujarat Education Service, under the Directorate of Primary Education, Gujarat State, shall be made either,"
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-
 - (i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Assistant Education Inspector, Class III, in the subordinate services of the Directorate of Primary Education Gujarat State;
 - (ii) have passed the departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government; and
 - (iii) have Passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

- (b) by direct selection.
3. The appointments by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in the ratio of 2:1, respectively.
4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
- (A) not be more than 42 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned;

- (B) possess,- a bachelor's degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institutions recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and
- (i) a bachelor's degree in education obtained from any of the Teacher Educational Institutions recognised by the National Council for Teacher Education(NCTE); or
- (ii) a bachelor's degree in special education obtained from any of the Teacher Educational Institutions recognised by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI); or
- (iii) have completed two years certificate course of Primary Teachers Certificate or Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) of State Examination Board of Gujarat obtained from any of the Teacher Educational Institutions recognised by the National Council for Teacher Education(NCTE); and
- (C) have about five years' separate or combined experience of teaching or inspection or administration in the Government/Panchayat/Local Bodies/Grant-in-Aid/Non Grant-in-Aid Primary School/Upper Primary School/Secondary Education School/Higher Secondary Education School/D.El.Ed. College/B.Ed. College /District Institute of Education and Training on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Head Teacher, Class III in the subordinate service of the Directorate of the Primary Education after obtaining the requisite qualification as prescribed in rule 4(B) above;

- (D) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and
- (E) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
 6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
 7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
 8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
 9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
 10. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
 11. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
