Professional conferred by sub-section (1) of section 20 read with section 4 of the
Technical Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institutions
Educational (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007 (Guj.2 of
Colleges or 2008), the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules
Institutions further to amend the Professional Diploma Courses (Regulation of
(Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules, 2008, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Professional Diploma Courses (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 2011.

2. In the Professional Diploma Courses (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules, 2008 (hereinafter referred to as "the said rules"), in rule 5,-

(1) in sub-rule (1) ,after the clause (iii) the following clauses shall be added, namely:-

"(iii-a) the National Institute of Open Schooling:

Provided that,-

(a) the study centre/school in which the candidate has studied, shall have been located in the State of Gujarat; or

(b) the study centre/school in which the candidate has studied, shall have been located in the Union Territories of Diu, Daman and Dadra Nagar Haveli and whose parents are origin of Gujarat; or

(iii-b) the International School Board:

Provided that,-

(a) the school in which the candidate has studied, shall have been located in the State of Gujarat; or

(b) the school in which the candidate has studied, shall have been located in the Union Territories of Diu, Daman and Dadra Nagar Haveli and whose parents are origin of Gujarat; or";

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(2) for sub-rules (5) to (7), the following sub-rules shall be substituted, namely:-

“(5) A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination after appearing in the supplementary examination conducted by the Board shall not be eligible for admission in the current academic year.

(6) For the purpose of admission a candidate shall have obtained minimum marks as specified in the table below:-

3. In the said rules, after rule 8, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

“8A. Reservation for Candidates of Border District.- (1)

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the seats shall be reserved for the candidates who have studied in the schools situated in the Border Districts, in accordance with the scheme under Border Area Development Programme (BADP) of the Government of India for the educational development in the Border areas of Gujarat, in the colleges/institutes and the courses as specified in the Table below :-

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(2) To avail the benefit of admission under the scheme referred in sub-rule (1) , a candidate shall have to produce a certificate issued by the Principal of the school in which the candidate has studied, being located in one of the areas of the Border Districts.

Explanation.- “Border District” means and includes the revenue area of Banaskantha District, Katchchh District and Radhanpur and Santalpur Talukas of Patan District, of the Gujarat State.”.

4. In the said rules, in rule 9, -

(1) for sub-rule (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:-


“(2) **Admission under Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme.**- (i) the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme shall be applicable to all the sanctioned seats of the diploma engineering courses in the Government colleges or institutions , grant-in-aided colleges or institutions and unaided colleges or institutions approved by AICTE, New Delhi;

(ii) the supernumerary seats not exceeding five percent of sanctioned intake of the colleges or institutions shall be filled on the basis of merit of the candidate, the annual income of whose parents is less than Rs. 2.5 lakhs from all sources of income.

(iii) the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme shall be for the complete duration of the course and the students admitted under this scheme shall not be allowed to change the institution or the course under any circumstances.”.

(2) after sub-rule (5), the following sub-rules shall be added, namely:-

“(6) **The supernumerary seats for Foreign Nationals or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) or the children of Indian workers in Gulf countries.**- The supernumerary seats for Foreign Nationals or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) or the children of Indian workers in Gulf countries not more than 15% of the sanctioned intake shall be applicable to all the Government Colleges or institutions, grant-in-aid colleges or institutions or unaided colleges or institutions approved by AICTE, subject to the condition that upto 1/3rd of the 15% shall be reserved in the different disciplines in all the college or institution, for the Children of Indian Workers in the Gulf Countries. The remaining seats of such category shall be reserved for the Foreign Nationals or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO). The Foreign Nationals or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) or the children of Indian Workers in the Gulf Countries admitted through Indian



Council for Cultural Relation (ICCR or as Government of India nominee) shall be included in their respective category.

(7) The supernumerary seats remain vacant shall not be offered to anyone other than the respective category.”.

5. In the said rules, in rule 17, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) A candidate who gets admission shall have to pay such fees, at such stages, as may be determined by the Fee Regulatory Committee constituted under section 9 of the Act, for the unaided colleges or institutions.
